

Collaborative leader at Fanshawe to receive OCASA Distinguished Administrator Award



A leader who takes time to explain purchasing and listens to the concerns of budget managers at Fanshawe College has been named OCASA 2013 Distinguished Administrator.

Corinne Campbell, Manager, Purchasing and Accounts Payable, at Fanshawe, will receive the award June 24 at the OCASA Professional Development Conference at King City.

In her 23 years at the college, Ms. Campbell's has shown "integrity and strong commitment to high standards," her nominators stressed.

The OCASA Distinguished Administrator Award recognizes administrators who have demonstrated distinguished administrative performance, showing outstanding leadership, consistent professionalism and overall effectiveness.

At Fanshawe she currently serves on the Board of Governors, is currently vice-president of the Fanshawe Administrative Staff Association, and has served on numerous committees, including the Copyright Working Group.

Corinne was instrumental in the successful implementation of the College enterprise system, leading the payables and purchasing team in the college wide implementation.

She lead her department — and the college — as an early adapter of scanning technology for document administration, and was instrumental in Fanshawe's adopting the

negotiated request for proposal templates for purchasing — the first Ontario College to do so.

“Her approach was collegial and informed,” her nominator stressed. “She made me feel like a full partner in understanding and resolving the challenges I faced with my initial fiscal responsibilities.”

She has been active beyond the college, and in 2009 acted as registrar and planning team member for the ASCC conference, held that year in London, Ont. She is a past chair of the Ontario College Purchasing Management Association.
