 2. Background: Why do we need this committee? there was general agreement with the need, due to cumbersome process and 29 board members. also agreed that the voice of all college reps is still critical to the boards decision making (
 3. OCASA's Governance structure: What works well? What doesn't work well? What should we consider size is large, no formal election process, backfilling officers – difficult to process, potential error do we need to backfill? may want to cut down number – i.e. 3 reps from each region should there be a category of individuals defined as college reps – then select board of directors; or take board members from broad membership, separate from college reps or could have some seats that are members at large Issue: continuity; some turnover over time; some defined term of service should ensure regional representation board appointment should be for more than a year (3 year term, max 2 terms) Need to clarify board role vs college rep role
